






2. How well did the teachers prepare for the class?






3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?






4. The teacher's approach to teaching can be best described as






5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teacher






6. Was your performance in assignments/ tests discussed with you?






7. The institution takes initiatives to promote intership, inplant training, field visit for students






8. The teaching and mentoring process offered by the institution support your cognitive, social and emotional growth.






9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow






10. Teacher inform you about your expected competencies, course outcome and programme outcomes






11. Your mentor(Faculty advisor) does necessary follow-up with the assigned task to you






12. The teacher illustrates the concept through examples and illustrations






13. The teacher identifies your strengths and courage with providing right level of challenges






14. Teachers are able to identify your weakness and help you to overcome them






15. Institution makes effort to engage students in the mentoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process






16. Institution/Teachers use student centric methods, such as experimental learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing teaching learning process






17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extra- curricular activities






18. Efforts are made by the institution/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work
